Tea, Coffee etc will be served after both Solemn Masses: 9:15 and 11:15. We very much hope you can stay.

Today at both churches we will keep the feast of All Saints – I am not sure this is strictly accurate, however it is difficult to have a Solemn Mass two evenings running (especially in the winter!) so I have moved All Saints to the Sunday this year, and All Souls will be Solemn on the Thursday.

*Mass Times: *Monday's Mass is now in the morning at 10:00am – this is more practical in the winter months. **Tuesday's Mass this week is also at 10:00am owing to a School Governor's meeting that evening.

Thursday is All Souls Day: there will be a Low Mass of Requiem at 12 noon at S Saviour's, and also a Solemn Requiem Mass at 8pm at S Mary's. Please print the names of your departed loved ones on the sheets in the churches. Please do so legibly! Please try and get to mass that day at whichever church is most convenient for you timewise.

Safeguarding – PCC's: Safeguarding is rightly being taken very seriously now across all parishes and dioceses, and it is encouraged that all PCC members (and obligatory that those who work directly with children and vulnerable adults) attend Safeguarding Training. This is offered at various churches around the diocese, and both daytime and evening events are available.
